

# Britain heads for historic Brexit ballot

Britain's House of Commons is to vote on the Withdrawal Agreement – the terms on which the UK will leave the EU – with Prime Minister Theresa May needing support from Labour rebels to win approval

How parties may vote in 650-seat lower chamber

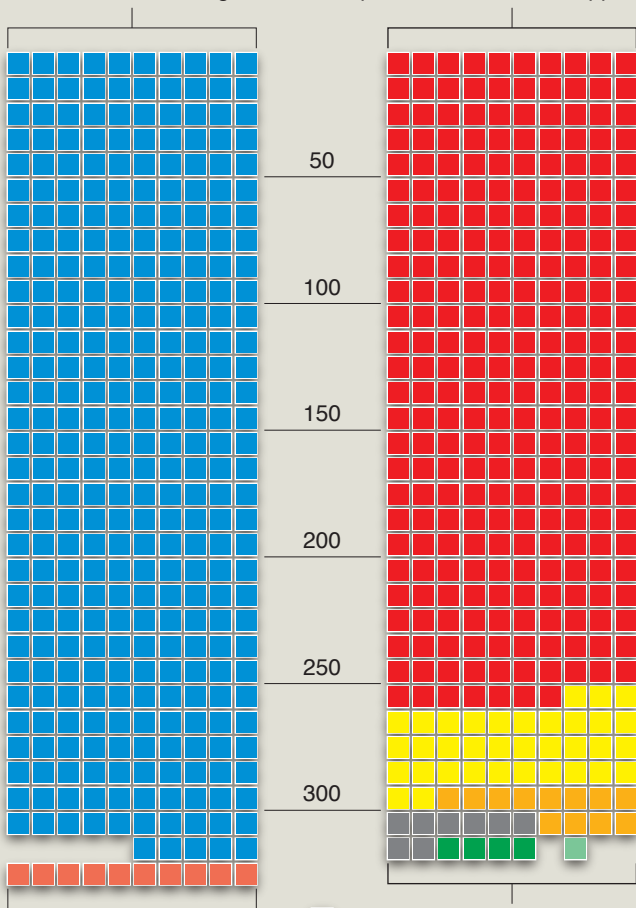
**Speaker** Has casting vote (*last used in 1980*)

**Conservatives: 315**

50-plus MPs could vote against

**Labour: 257**

Up to 20 rebels could support deal



**Democratic Unionist Party\*: 10**

Suggested it will vote against

**Scottish National Party: 35**

**Liberal Democrats: 12**

**Independent: 8** **Plaid Cymru: 4**

**Green Party: 1** Will all vote against

**Sinn Féin: 7**

Abstentionist policy – will not vote

\*Conservatives and DUP have “confidence and supply” agreement which includes supporting government legislation pertaining to UK’s exit from EU
