▲ More than 100 people were killed as protesters attempted to reclaim Independence Square from riot police in the heart of the Ukrainian capital, Kiev

1994: Swiss voters approved a ban on all foreign trans-Alpine freight travelling by road rather than by rail

2004: Iranian conservatives won disputed elections after liberal candidates were barred from running

2009: Likud leader Benjamin Netanyahu was invited to form Israel's next government after Tzipi Livni's Kadima failed to form a coalition

2009: Swedish automaker Saab filed for bankruptcy
