

Tensions rise over aid to Venezuela

Aid convoys from international allies supporting Venezuela's opposition risk becoming the focus of confrontation with troops loyal to President Nicolás Maduro

Self-declared interim president, pressing army to let aid into country.

\$20 million in U.S. aid expected to be unloaded in points outside Venezuelan territory



Nicolás Maduro

Denies existence of humanitarian crisis and views aid effort as pretext for U.S.-led military intervention
