March 25, 1655

▲ **Christiaan Huygens, Dutch astronomer and mathematician, discovered Saturn's largest moon, Titan. Huygens also determined the nature of Saturn's rings**

1954: The first colour television went on sale for around \$1,000, roughly the same cost as a car at that time

1995: WikiWikiWeb, the world's first user-editable website, was created

2009: Scientists reported that debris from an asteroid had been recovered for the first time after it fell to Earth

2009: Sweden's Parliament announced that the 50-öre coin would cease to be legal tender from September 30, 2010
