▲ **The first successful non-direct blood transfusion, using stored blood rather than transfusing directly from donor to receiver, was performed**

1899: Guglielmo Marconi made the first international radio transmission between France and England

1994: Media mogul Silvio Berlusconi seized victory in Italy's general elections

1994: A prototype of the four-nation Eurofighter aircraft made a successful test flight in Germany

2017: The Big Maple Leaf, a 100kg Canadian gold coin worth \$4.5m, was stolen from a Berlin museum
