

Google's game-changing new platform

Google has unveiled a new cloud gaming platform called *Stadia*, which will stream console-quality video games to multiple devices

Television (via Chromecast)

Equivalent of console running at 10.7 GPU teraflops – more than **PS4 Pro** and **Xbox One X** combined



Compatible gameplay videos will feature **Play Now** button, allowing viewers to jump in and start playing game themselves

*Reduces latency or lag (delay between player performing action, and game reacting to that move)
