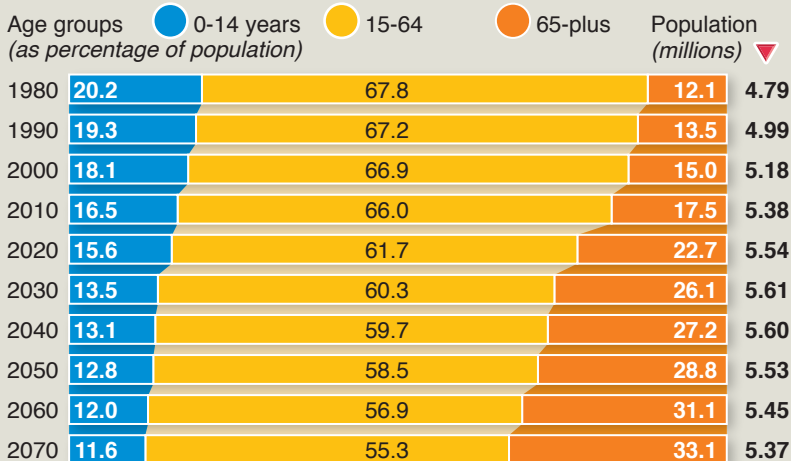


# Finland's demographic timebomb

Finland faces growing pressures of an ageing and shrinking population, with one in three people being older than 65 by 2070. The Nordic nation saw its death rate eclipse its birth rate in 2016



**1980:** There were **5.6** working age people supporting each person aged over 65 years

**2070:** Just **1.7** working age people per person over 65
