▲ **The Rolling Stones, the first album by the group of the same name, was released. It became a big international hit, and topped the UK charts for 12 weeks**

1948: The Organisation for European Economic Co-operation (OEEC) was set up in Paris

2009: Maoist rebels killed 17 police and election officials in four Indian states as the general election began

2017: President Recep Tayyip Erdogan of Turkey won a historic referendum on a package of constitutional changes granting him sweeping new powers

2018: Netflix announced it now had over 125 million subscribers
