▲ **Nelson Mandela cast his vote in South Africa's first all-race elections, which resulted in a resounding victory for Mandela and the African National Congress**

1981: Xerox PARC introduced the first commercially available computer mouse

2007: Estonia suffered a major cyber-attack when unprecedented internet activity took down many banks

2009: An ill-advised publicity flight for Air Force One sparked panic in New York, reviving memories of 9/11. The U.S. Air Force tracked the negative public reaction on Twitter

2018: Korean leaders Kim Jong-un and Moon Jae-in held a historic summit
