

# The Mueller investigation

A summary of U.S. Special Counsel Robert Mueller's 22-month probe into Russia's role in the 2016 U.S. election concludes that it did not find any evidence that Donald Trump or his associates broke the law

## Key findings

### ■ No collusion:

Mueller's report states "investigation did not establish that members of the Trump Campaign conspired or coordinated with the Russian government in its election interference activities"

### ■ No obstruction of Justice:

Evidence is "not sufficient to establish that the president committed an obstruction-of-justice offence"

"While this report does not conclude that the president committed a crime, it also does not exonerate him"

## Trump associates charged...



### 1 Paul Manafort:

Trump's former campaign chairman. **Guilty** of five counts of tax fraud. Sentenced to combined 7.5 years in prison



### 2 Michael Cohen:

Trump's former personal lawyer. **Pleaded guilty** to crimes including paying "hush money" in violation of campaign laws. Sentenced to three years in prison



### 3 Michael Flynn:

Former national security adviser **pleaded guilty** to lying to FBI about his contacts with Russia. Sentencing is pending



### 4 Roger Stone:

Longtime Trump ally charged with seven criminal counts including obstruction, witness tampering and making false statements. **Pleaded not guilty**



### 5 George

**Papadopoulos:** Former Trump campaign adviser sentenced to 14 days in prison after **pleading guilty** to lying to FBI about his contacts with Russian officials



### 6 Rick Gates:

Former deputy chairman of Trump's campaign.

**Pleaded guilty** to conspiracy against U.S. and lying to investigators. Sentencing is pending
