▲ **The Channel Tunnel, which linked Britain and France for the first time since the Ice Age, was opened by Queen Elizabeth II and President Francois Mitterrand**

1974: West Germany's Chancellor Willy Brandt resigned after an aide was found to be an East German spy

1999: NATO leaders and Russia reached agreement on principle on a peace plan for Kosovo

2004: The International Red Cross reported widespread mistreatment of prisoners by coalition forces in jails across Iraq

2004: The final episode of the popular TV sitcom *Friends* aired in the U.S.
