

Indonesia holds epic elections

The world's largest single-day elections will see 192 million voters electing the president, members of parliament and almost 20,000 other positions in regional councils across 18,000 islands

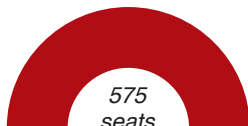

LEGISLATIVE ELECTION

More than **245,000** candidates will contest over **20,000** legislative seats at five levels of government. In just six hours, votes will be cast at **809,500** polling stations scattered across **1.9 million** sq km of world's third largest democracy
