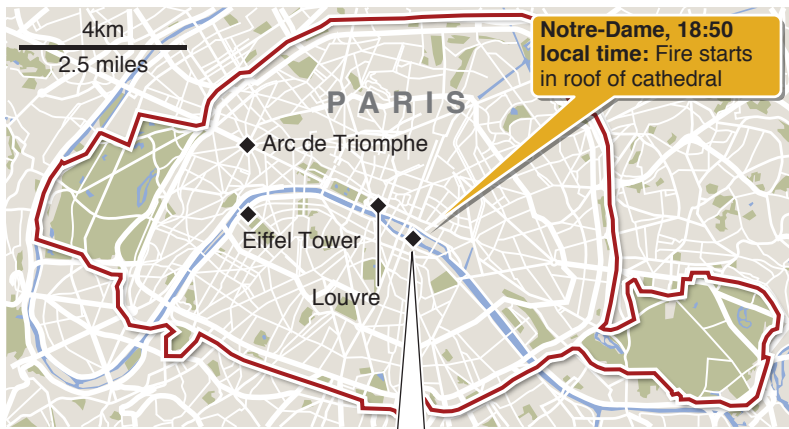


Paris Notre-Dame cathedral fire
