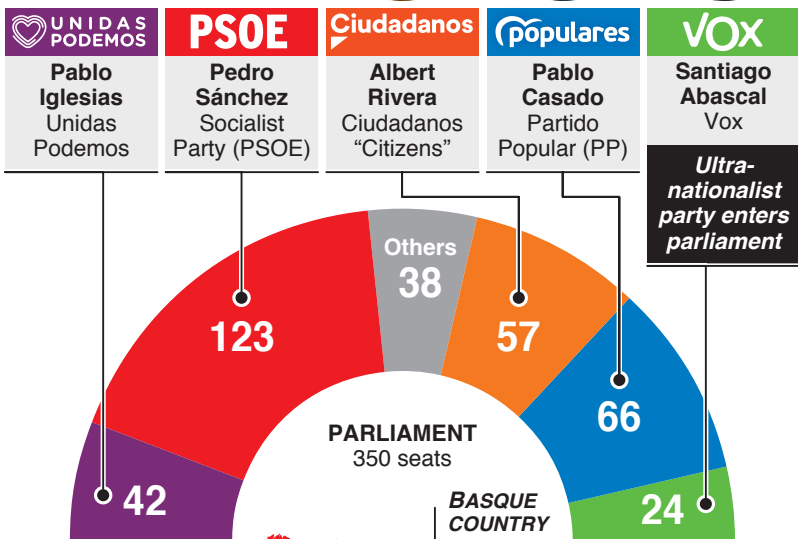


Socialists win Spain elections

The Socialists retained power in Spain's third election in four years, but fell short of a majority. For the first time since military rule ended in the 1970s, a far-right party is set to enter parliament



Sánchez likely to try to form coalition with Basque nationalists (PNV) and other regional parties to avoid contentious negotiations with Catalan secessionists, who won 22 seats and still demand right to self-determination



CATALONIA:
Centre-left Republican Left of Catalonia (ERC) was region's big winner, with 15 seats
