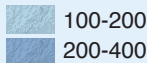


Rains torment cyclone-hit Mozambique

Torrential rain is battering northern Mozambique, grounding aid operations and hampering efforts to reach communities worst hit by Cyclone Kenneth, the strongest cyclone ever to hit Africa

Apr 25: Cyclone Kenneth makes landfall with winds of 220km/h, killing dozens of people and devastating villages

COMOROS: At least four people killed, 75,000 homes damaged

Ibo island: Most homes destroyed

Pemba: Some 200,000 people in danger. Nearly 35,000 houses completely or partially destroyed. Around 31,000 hectares of crops lost
