▲ A U.S. toy company registered the trade mark Frisbee for its flying disc, the nickname adopted because of its similarity to dishes used by the Frisbie Pie Company

1659: Aurangzeb, sixth and last of the great Mughal emperors, formally ascended the throne

1908: The first major oil strike in the Middle East was made in Persia, now called Iran

1969: John Lennon and Yoko Ono began their "Bed-In" for world peace

2018: Real Madrid win the UEFA Champions League title for the third consecutive year, and their 13th title overall
