▲ **Chinese army tanks entered Tiananmen Square in Beijing to oust pro-democracy protesters. Death toll estimates range from a few hundred into the thousands**

1937: The supermarket trolley made a first appearance at a store in the U.S. state of Oklahoma

2009: U.S. President Barack Obama called for a “new beginning” in relations between the U.S. and the Muslim world

2010: SpaceX’s Falcon 9 rocket was successfully launched on its maiden test flight from Cape Canaveral

2011: China’s Li Na became the first Asian tennis player to win a Grand Slam singles title, at Roland Garros
