▲ **Actress Meryl Streep was born. Nominated for a record 21 Oscars, she has won three, for Kramer vs Kramer (1979), Sophie's Choice (1982), and The Iron Lady (2011)**

1814: The first cricket match was played at Lord's in London

1969: U.S. musical actress and singer Judy Garland died of a drugs overdose in her London flat, aged 47

1989: Seven student leaders of the Tiananmen Square demonstrations were executed after trial in China

2010: Jamaican police arrested suspected drug lord Christopher "Dudus" Coke on the outskirts of Kingston
