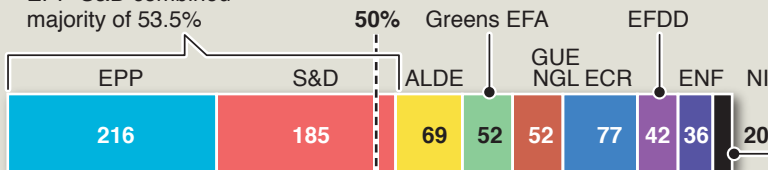


European Parliament election results

European Parliament elections determine who will represent EU citizens over the next five years, with 751 members (MEPs) sitting in eight cross-national groups affiliated with their national parties

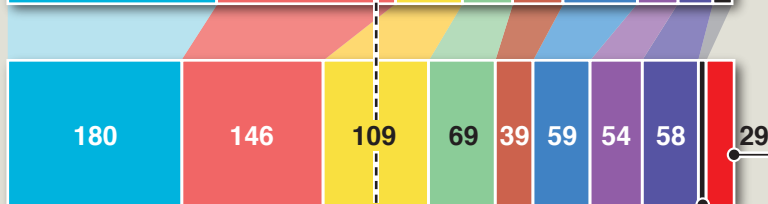
OUTGOING 2014-19 PARLIAMENT (Seats at end of April 2019)

EFDD: Europe of Freedom and Direct Democracy. Includes **Brexit Party** (UK), **Alternative for Germany (AfD)**, **Five Star Movement** (Italy), **Les Patriotes** (France), **Debout la France**

NI – Non-Inscrits: Not attached to any cross-national group

S&D: Alliance of Socialists and Democrats

Greens/European Free Alliance

ECR: European Conservatives and Reformists. Includes **Law and Justice party** (Poland), **Danish People's Party (DPP)**, **Finns Party**

ENF: Europe of Nations and Freedom. Includes **Lega** (Italy), **National Rally (RN)** (France), **Freedom Party (FPÖ)** (Austria), **Party for Freedom (PVV)** (Netherlands)
