Boris Johnson, 54

Face of Brexit campaign. Resigned as Foreign Secretary in protest at Theresa May's handling of exit negotiations

Odds of winning: **5/6**



Dominic Raab, 45

Quit as May's Brexit minister in protest at her draft exit agreement, saying it did not match Tory party promises

Odds: **5/1**



Michael Gove, 51

Environment Secretary. Rebuilt cabinet career after losing to May in contest to replace David Cameron

Odds: **11/1**



Jeremy Hunt, 52

Replaced Johnson as Foreign Secretary. Wants to unite against EU

Odds: **16/1**



Rory Stewart, 46

Former diplomat promoted to International Development Secretary

Odds: **20/1**



Andrea Leadsom, 56

Quit as Leader of House of Commons due to Brexit strategy

Odds: **20/1**



Penny Mordaunt, 46

Recently became UK's first female Defence Secretary

Odds: **22/1**



Sajid Javid, 49

Home Secretary and second-generation Pakistani immigrant

Odds: **22/1**



Matthew Hancock, 40

Health Secretary, former banker. Voted Remain in referendum

Odds: **50/1**
