Monday: President and First Lady **Melania Trump** arrive in London, accompanied by four of his children: **Ivanka, Tiffany, Eric** and **Donald Trump Jr.**, plus spouses

■ **Ceremonial welcome:** In gardens of Buckingham Palace, followed by lunch which **Duke of Sussex** will attend, but not wife **Meghan**

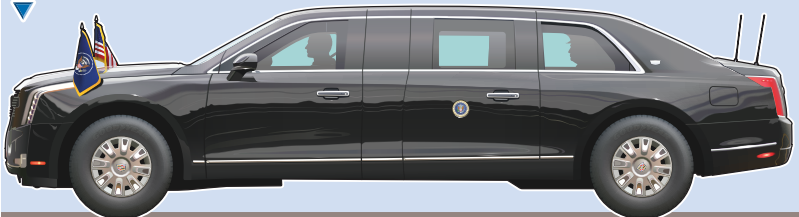
■ Trumps will lay wreath at grave of Unknown Warrior in Westminster Abbey before joining **Prince Charles** and **Duchess of Cornwall** for afternoon tea at Clarence House

■ **Monday evening:** Trump entourage attends state banquet at Buckingham Palace. White tie dinner will see some 150 royals, politicians and other guests gather in palace ballroom

■ **The Beast:** Motorcades will feature General Motors-built Cadillac limousine, with 125mm thick armour, capable of withstanding roadside bombs

Tuesday: Prime Minister **Theresa May** (below) and U.S. president co-host business breakfast meeting, attended by **Duke of York**, at St James's Palace

■ President will then visit Downing Street and hold talks with Prime Minister May, followed by joint press conference – one of May's final acts as Conservative leader

■ President will be greeted with anti-Trump demonstrations in central London, including six-metre tall **Baby Trump** blimp

Wednesday: President and First Lady will join **the Queen** and Prince Charles at national commemorative event of 75th anniversary of D-Day landings at Southsea Common, Portsmouth

■ **Wednesday evening:** President flies to Ireland. Spends night at Trump International Golf Links in Doonbeg, Co. Clare, before leaving for Normandy, France, to attend D-Day anniversary
