▲ **Brian Jones, a founder member of British rock band The Rolling Stones, was found drowned in his swimming pool a month after being dismissed from the band**

1989: The U.S. Supreme Court upheld a Missouri state law banning abortions unless the mother's life was in danger

2004: Tennis player Maria Sharapova, aged 17, beat defending champion Serena Williams to win Wimbledon

2004: President Omar al-Bashir of Sudan pledged to take steps to disarm the Arab Janjaweed militia

2015: The Solar Impulse flew from Japan to Hawaii, the longest ever solo flight without refuelling
