**1884:** The Statue of Liberty was presented to the United States of America by the people of France

**1904:** Construction of the Panama Canal linking the Atlantic and Pacific oceans, began

**1934:** Polish-born physicist Marie Curie, a double Nobel laureate, died

**2009:** New Zealand revealed that three people had died after contracting swine flu, the country's first fatalities linked to the H1N1 flu
