▲ **A severe heatwave began in Japan. Prolonged temperatures of up to 40°C left at least 80 people dead and over 22,000 requiring hospitalisation**

**1993:** The Nunavut Act was passed in Canada, leading to the creation in 1999 of Nunavut, Canada's largest territory

**1999: NATO troops found 350 bodies in a ravine in Kosovo, victims of a massacre by Serb paramilitaries**

**2004:** The International Court of Justice ruled that Israel's West Bank security barrier violated international law

**2004:** A U.S. Senate Committee reported that false and misleading information preceded the 2003 invasion of Iraq
