July 13, 1814

▲ The Carabinieri, the national gendarmerie of Italy and one of the country's four Armed Forces, was established. It polices both military and civilian populations

1999: Iranian students demanding democratic reforms clashed with the authorities in Tehran

2009: Turkey, Bulgaria, Romania, Hungary and Austria signed an agreement to build the Nabucco natural gas pipeline
