

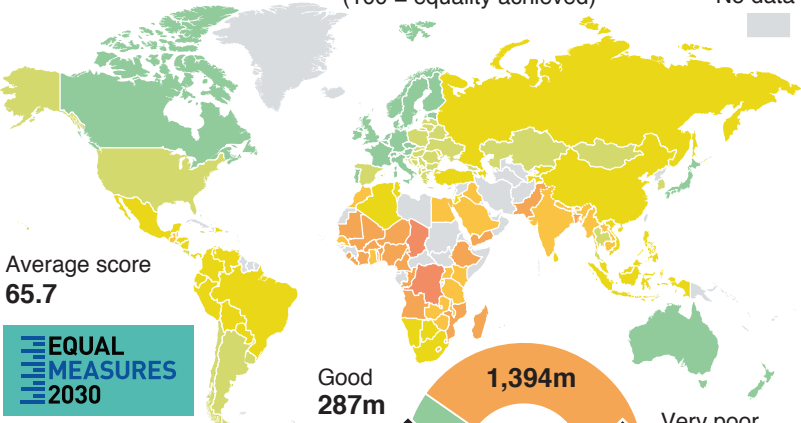
# World off track on gender equality targets

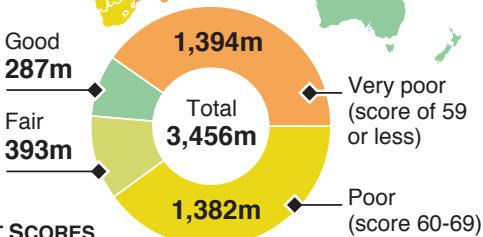
