

Deadline looms for Trump's Mexico tariffs

U.S. President Donald Trump is threatening to impose import taxes on all goods from Mexico in an effort to persuade America's southern neighbour to do more to stop illegal migration



Donald Trump says he will impose 5% tax on all Mexican goods starting June 10 – potential cost to U.S. businesses and consumers of more than \$17 billion
