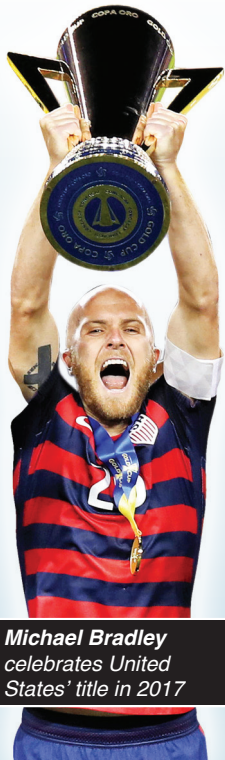


CONCACAF Gold Cup winners

Since the first Gold Cup in 1991, nine nations have reached the final, with just three going on to lift the trophy. Perennial rivals Mexico and the United States have dominated the tournament – sharing 13 titles apiece – with Canada's sole triumph in 2000
