

Mohammed Morsi



■ **1951:** *Mohamed Morsi* born in Nile Delta province of Sharqiya

■ **1970s:** Studies engineering at Cairo University before moving to U.S. to complete PhD

■ **1985:** Returns to Egypt, becoming head of engineering department at Zagazig University

■ **1977:** Joins Islamist *Muslim Brotherhood*

■ **2000-05:** Heads Brotherhood's unofficial bloc in Parliament, serving as independent

■ **2011:** Detained during uprising that toppled President *Hosni Mubarak*, escaping from prison two days later with thousands of other inmates

■ **Apr 2012:** Chosen to run in presidential election after Brotherhood's original candidate is forced to pull out

■ **Jun: Becomes Egypt's first democratically elected president**

■ **Jul 3, 2013:** Removed by then army chief and current President *Abdel Fattah al-Sisi* amid massive popular protests against his rule

Bloody security crackdown follows, leaving Brotherhood in disarray

■ **Nov 2013:** First appearance since ousting, at trial on charges of inciting violence – first of several court cases against him

■ **Apr 2015:** Morsi sentenced to 20 years in jail on charges linked to killing of protesters in 2012

■ **May:** Sentenced to death over prison break during 2011 uprising – conviction later overturned

■ **Jun 17, 2019:** Dies at age 67 after collapsing in court during trial for espionage
