


Airbus strong at Paris Air Show

Airbus kicked off the Paris Air Show by unveiling its A321XLR – a new long-range aircraft – and announcing \$13 billion of orders

Airbus A321XLR: Available from 2023

Range: 4,700 nautical miles (8,700km)

Passengers: Up to 220 in two-class seating configuration



Engines: CFM International Leap-1A or Pratt & Whitney PW1100G – 30% less fuel burn per seat compared to original A321 neo
