World No.1 could suffer from lack of grass court time after bruising loss to **Dominic Thiem** at Roland Garros

Roger Federer

Eight-time champion returns two decades after debut – and on form after 10th title at Halle

Rafael Nadal

Only two majors behind Federer after winning 12th Paris crown – but has not won here since 2010

Kevin Anderson

2018 finalist boosted four places in seeds despite limited court time due to elbow injury
