

# Trump's face-to-face itinerary at G20

U.S. President Donald Trump will meet one-on-one with at least eight world leaders on the sidelines of the G20 summit in Osaka, Japan



**Friday, 8:30am**  
**Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe**

Trump has lashed out at his host over U.S.-Japan defence alliance, saying U.S. would defend Japan if attacked, but that there is no reciprocal obligation. **Japan should pay more towards stationing of 54,000 U.S. troops**



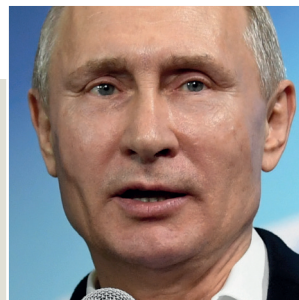
**9:35am: Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi**

Trump has called on Modi to withdraw **"unacceptable"** tariffs on U.S. goods after scrapping trade concessions on \$6.3 billion of Indian exports to U.S.



**10:15am**  
**German Chancellor Angela Merkel**

Merkel delivered rebuke to Trump's policies at Harvard University in May, calling on graduates to **"tear down walls of ignorance and narrow-mindedness"**



**2:00pm**  
**Russian President Vladimir Putin**

No agenda – possible new nuclear arms treaty that could include China. **Leaders remain far apart on Ukraine, Syrian civil war, and key near-term threats including Iran and North Korea**



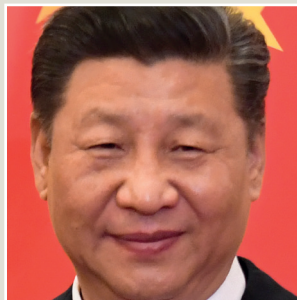
**Friday, 3:30pm**  
**Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro**

Dubbed **"Trump of the Tropics"**, Bolsonaro and U.S. president share similar nationalist ideologies. **Likely to discuss regime change in Venezuela and ban on China's Huawei from Brazil's 5G network**



**Saturday, 8:15am**  
**Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman**

Trump has pushed back against pressure from Congress to end U.S. support for Saudi-led war in Yemen. **MbS could play critical role in U.S. strategy to counter Iran**



**11:30am**  
**Chinese President Xi Jinping**

U.S.-China trade war talks deteriorated after Trump imposed 25% tariffs on Chinese goods in May. **White House is eager for some type of accord as Trump begins 2020 re-election campaign**



**1:05pm: Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan**

Growing rift between NATO allies over Turkey's purchase of Russian S-400 surface-to-air missile systems. **U.S. threatening to suspend deliveries of F-35 Joint Strike Fighters to Turkey**
