*July 18, 1814*

▲ Explorer Matthew Flinders's book, *A Voyage To Terra Australis*, was published in London. It is credited with bringing the name **Australia** into common use

**1925:** Adolf Hitler published the first volume of his book, *Mein Kampf*

**1976:** Romanian gymnast **Nadia Comaneci**, aged 14, became the first person in Olympic history to score a "perfect 10", at the Montreal Games

**1994:** A ceasefire was declared in Rwanda, ending the genocide of Tutsis and moderate Hutus

**2009:** Bakers in the Palestinian city of Nablus created the world's biggest kunafa, a local sweet pastry
