July 25, 1959

▲ The hovercraft made its first crossing of the English Channel. The SR-N1 crossed from Calais to Dover in two hours, with inventor Christopher Cockerell on board

1925: TASS (Telegraph Agency of the Soviet Union) was established as the country's central information agency

1994: Israeli premier Yitzhak Rabin and Jordan's King Hussein ended 46 years of war between their countries

2010: Wikileaks released over 92,000 U.S. documents related to the war in Afghanistan

2018: Former cricketer Imran Khan became prime minister of Pakistan after an election marred by violence
