▲ **Macbeth, king of Scotland immortalised in Shakespeare's play, was defeated at Dunsinane by Malcolm Canmore and Siward of Northumbria**

1694: The Bank of England was founded by an Act of Parliament

1974: The U.S. House Judiciary Committee voted to impeach President Richard Nixon over the Watergate affair

2003: U.S. teenager Michael Phelps, 18, set five world records at the world championships in Barcelona, Spain

2004: Monsoon floods affected over 42 million in India and Bangladesh, two thirds of which was submerged
