▲ **Anne Frank and her family were discovered by the Nazis after two years hiding in an attic room in Amsterdam. Anne's famous diary was published after the war**

1693: Champagne was unintentionally invented by Benedictine monk Dom Perignon

1789: During the French Revolution, the Constituent Assembly abolished all feudal privileges and rights

1854: Japanese merchant ships were ordered to hoist the Hinomaru flag to distinguish them from foreign ships. It then became Japan's national flag

1983: Bettino Craxi was sworn in as Italy's first Socialist prime minister
