▲ Mexican artist Jose Clemente Orozco died. One of the greatest mural painters of the 20th century, his works adorn many buildings in Mexico and the United States

1907: The Cunard liner Lusitania, torpedoed by Germany in 1915, set sail on its maiden voyage from Liverpool

1969: Scottish motor racing driver Jackie Stewart won his first F1 world title at the Italian Grand Prix

1994: The U.S. Army formally left Berlin, ending the U.S. presence in the once-divided city after nearly 50 years

2009: Drivers in Samoa switched from driving on the right hand side of the road to the left
