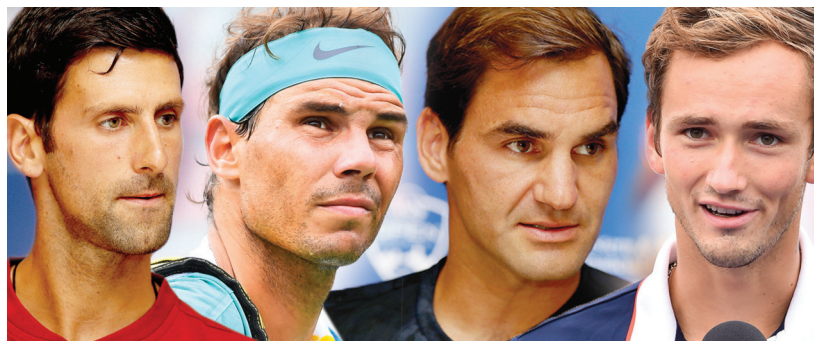

U.S Open 2019: Men's preview



Novak Djokovic

Has won four of last five majors, and reached U.S. Open semis or better every year since 2007

Rafael Nadal

Only two majors behind Federer – beat **Medvedev** to claim 35th Masters title in Montreal

Roger Federer

Five-time winner could suffer from lack of hard court practice – exited in fourth round in 2018

Daniil Medvedev

Ranked career-high No.5 after beating **Djokovic** en route to first Masters title in Cincinnati

2017 Rafael Nadal

Beat Kevin Anderson 6-3, 6-3, 6-4

2016 Stan Wawrinka

Beat Novak Djokovic 6-7, 6-4, 7-5, 6-3

2015 Novak Djokovic

Beat Roger Federer 6-4, 5-7, 6-4, 6-4
