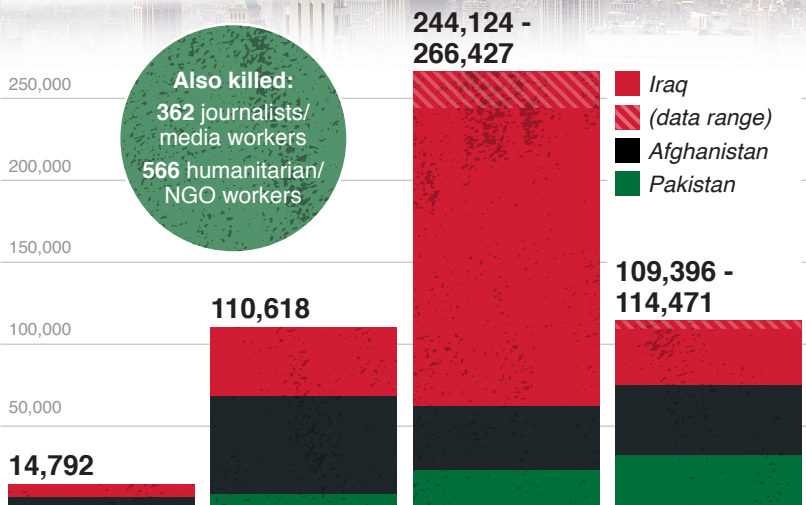


# Human cost of U.S. war on terror

Between 480,000 and 507,000 people have been killed in the United States' post-9/11 wars in Iraq, Afghanistan, and Pakistan, according to a Brown University study
