▲ A magnitude 7.5 earthquake hit Palu, on the Indonesian island of Sulawesi, triggering a tsunami and major soil liquefaction that killed over 2,200 people

1969: Fragments from a large meteorite that fell over Murchison, Australia, were found to contain extra-terrestrial amino acids

1994: Over 850 people died when the ferry Estonia sank in the Baltic Sea

2004: The price of oil surged past the \$50 milestone for the first time

2016: A Dutch investigation concluded Malaysia Airlines flight MH17 was shot down by a missile brought into Ukraine from Russia
