▲ **CERN (European Organization for Nuclear Research), the world's largest particle physics lab, and where Tim Berners-Lee created the World Wide Web, was founded**

1916: Oil industrialist John D. Rockefeller became the world's first billionaire

1992: Brazil's President Fernando Collor de Mello was impeached for receiving \$6.5m from a slush fund

2008: Ireland guaranteed deposits in six Irish banks, involving a potential liability of about \$400 billion

2014: Ashraf Ghani was sworn in as Afghanistan's first democratically elected president since 2001
