▲ **Robert the Bruce of Scotland inflicted a heavy defeat on King Edward II of England near York, thus forcing Edward to accept the independence of Scotland**

1964: U.S. civil rights leader Martin Luther King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize

1989: Election posters blossomed in Jordan for the kingdom's first parliamentary poll in 22 years

2004: Vladimir Putin and Hu Jintao demarcated the 4,345km (2,700-mile) border between Russia and China

2009: WWW creator Tim Berners-Lee apologised for unnecessary forward slashes in internet addresses
