

Rising tensions over Saudi oil attacks

The U.S. says Iran was behind two attacks on the Saudi oil industry that sent oil prices soaring. Tehran denies involvement in the strikes, which were claimed by Iran-aligned Houthi rebels in Yemen



Sep 14: Attacks on **Abqaiq** – world's biggest processing facility – and **Khurais** oilfield, both run by Saudi state oil company **Aramco**, knock out more than half of Kingdom's output

U.S. satellite images show multiple points of impact and that attacks came from west-north-west direction, suggesting launch sites in northern Gulf, Iran or Iraq
