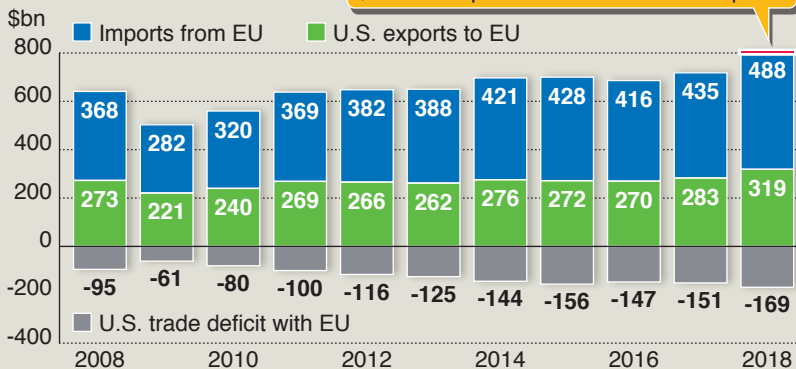


U.S. to put \$7.5bn in tariffs on EU goods

The World Trade Organization has given the United States the go-ahead to impose tariffs on \$7.5 billion in trade from Europe annually to retaliate against illegal EU subsidies for aviation giant Airbus
