

Chile unrest spreads

Civil unrest sparked by a subway fare hike has widened to reflect anger over high living costs and inequality in one of Latin America's wealthiest countries



Around 10,500 police and soldiers deployed.
More than 1,400 people arrested

Oct 21: Five people die after looters torch garment factory in suburb of Santiago, taking death toll in protests to at least eight



President **Sebastián Piñera** has cancelled fare hike and deployed troops for first time since end of **Pinochet** dictatorship in 1990. **Unrest has exposed divisions and intensified calls for economic reforms**
