

Russia sends more troops to Syria

Russia has sent around 300 more troops to Syria under an accord between Ankara and Moscow which halted Turkey's military incursion into northeast Syria, following the abrupt withdrawal of U.S. troops

Under Turkey-Russia deal, Kurdish fighters must retreat 30km from Turkish border by Oct 29

TURKEY

Turkish and Russian troops to conduct joint patrols 10km inside Syria, excluding Qamishli

Turkey to maintain land already seized but will not advance further
