▲ The RotoLactor, a rotating milking platform invented by Henry W. Jeffers that could milk 1,680 cows in seven hours, was installed at a dairy in New Jersey

**354:** Early Christian philosopher Saint Augustine of Hippo, patron saint of brewers and printers, was born

**1964:** Pope Paul VI offered to sell his three-tiered jewelled crown to benefit the world's poor

**1994:** Swedes voted by a majority of 52.2 percent in a referendum to join the European Union

**2015:** Coordinated terrorist attacks in Paris killed 130 people at a concert hall, stadium and bars
