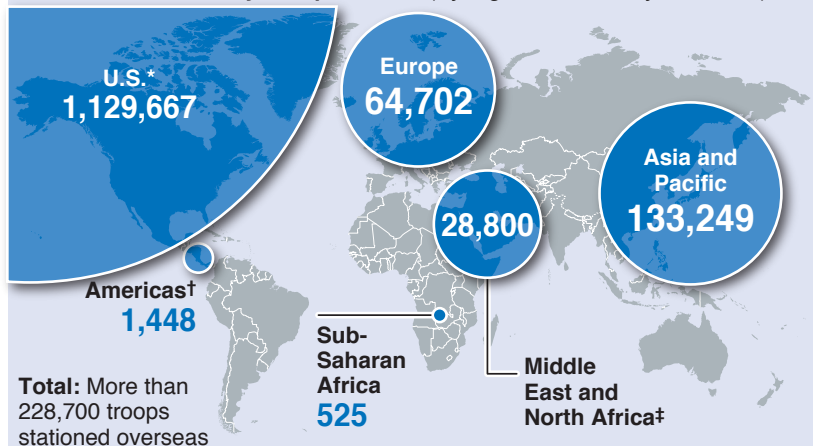


Growing U.S. military presence

The Trump administration wants countries hosting U.S. troops to pay the full cost plus 50 percent for the privilege – the U.S. currently maintains about 800 military facilities in some 80 countries

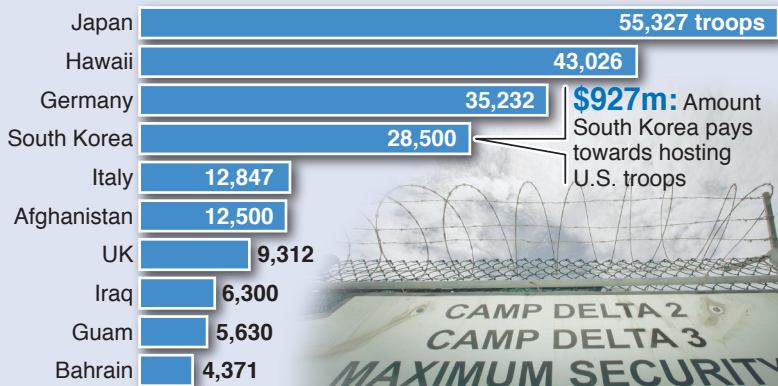
Number of active-duty U.S. personnel (By region and country, Jun 2019)
