

Russia to supply pipeline gas to China

Russia is planning to launch its first natural gas pipeline to China, known as Power of Siberia, as Moscow looks to reduce its dependence on European markets and feed China's growing demand for energy

POWER OF SIBERIA GAS PIPELINE

Length: Approximately 3,000km

First deliveries: Scheduled to begin Dec 2, 2019, under 30-year deal between Russia's state-owned Gazprom and China National Petroleum Corp (CNPC)

Export capacity: Pipeline to supply about five billion cubic metres (bcm) of gas in first year, rising to 38bcm per year in 2022-23*
