

Japan approves restart of tsunami-hit reactor

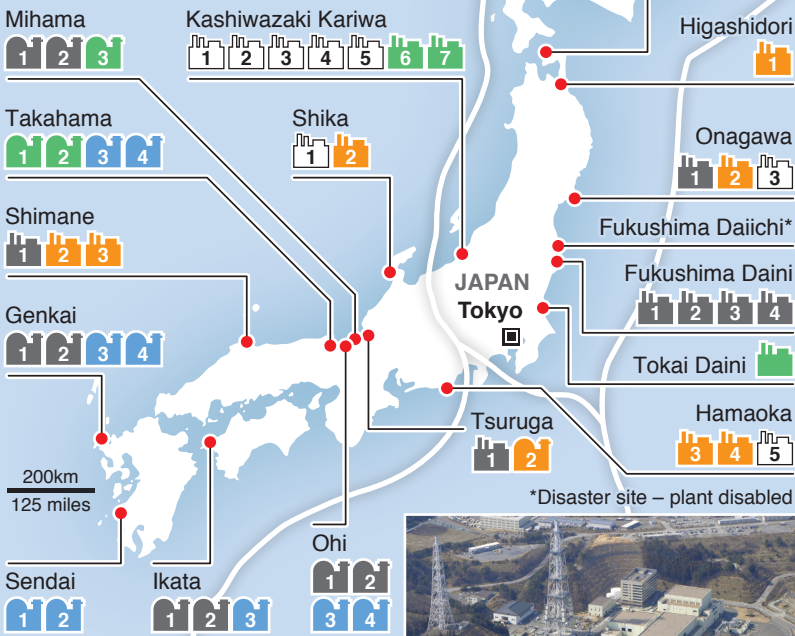
Tohoku Electric Power has won initial regulatory approval to restart a reactor at its Onagawa power plant – the closest nuclear facility to the epicentre of the 2011 earthquake that caused the Fukushima disaster
